

Spinning Stars

Cutting:

From the White floral print, cut:

(2) 4¼" x 4¼" squares**

From the Blue etching print, cut:

- (2) 3%" x 3%" squares*
- (1) 41/4" x 41/4" squares**

From the Pink leaf print, cut:

(2) 3%" x 3%" squares*

From the Pink floral print, cut:

(2) 3%" x 3%" squares*

From the Blue leaf print, cut:

(1) 41/4" x 41/4" squares**

Making the Corner Squares:

1. Sew the long side of (1) 3%" x 3%" blue etching triangle to the long side of (1) 3%" x 3%" pink leaf triangle. Press seam toward the pink leaf triangle. Make 4. Square and trim each square to measure 3½" x 3½", if needed.






Making the Side Squares:

1. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " blue etching triangle to (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " white floral triangle as shown to make a blue/white pieced triangle. Press seam toward the blue etching triangle. Make 4.






2. Sew the long side of a pieced triangle to the long side of (1) 3%" x 3%" pink floral triangle. Press seam toward the pink floral triangle to make a side square. Make 4. Square and trim each square to measure 3½" x 3½", if needed.

^{*} Cut each square in half diagonally once to get (2) triangles out of each square.

^{**} Cut each square in half diagonally twice to get (4) triangles out of each square.

Making the Center Square:

1. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " blue leaf triangle to (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " white floral triangle as shown to make a blue leaf/white pieced triangle. Press seam toward the blue leaf triangle. Make 2.







2. Sew the long side of a pieced triangle to the long side of a second pieced triangle as shown. Press seam open to make a center square. Make 1. Square and trim to measure 3½" x 3½", if needed.

Assembling the Block:

- 1. Lay out the (4) corner squares, the (4) side squares and the center square in three rows of three squares each, noting the orientation of each square.
- 2. Sew the squares together in each row. Press seams in the top and bottom row to the right. Press the seams in the middle row to the left.
- 3. Join the rows. Press seams in one direction to make a $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished square block.
